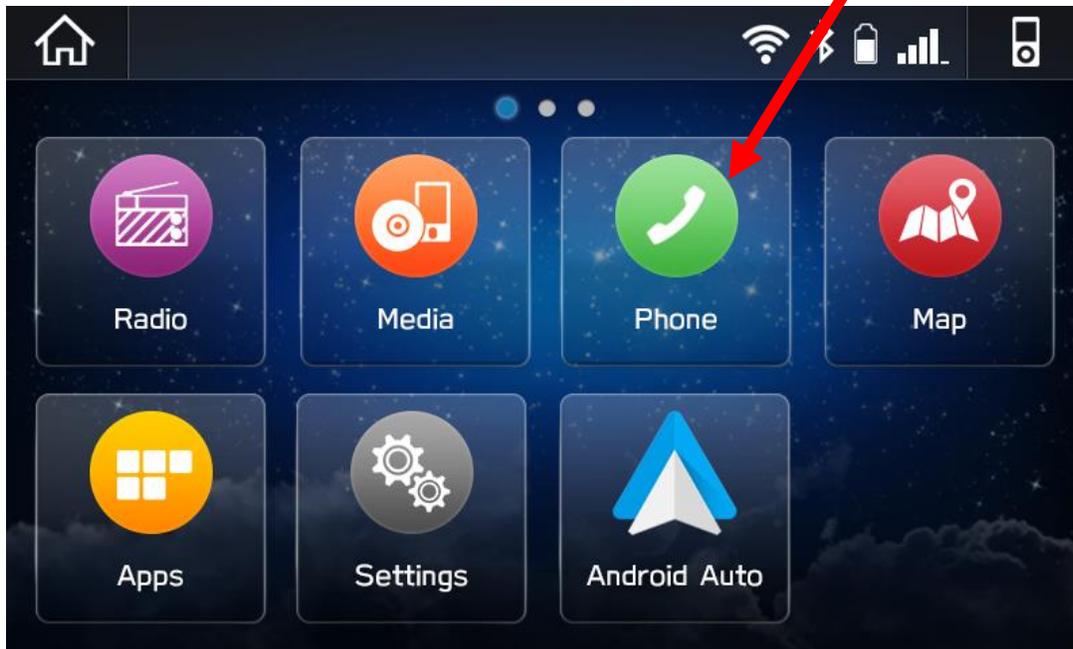
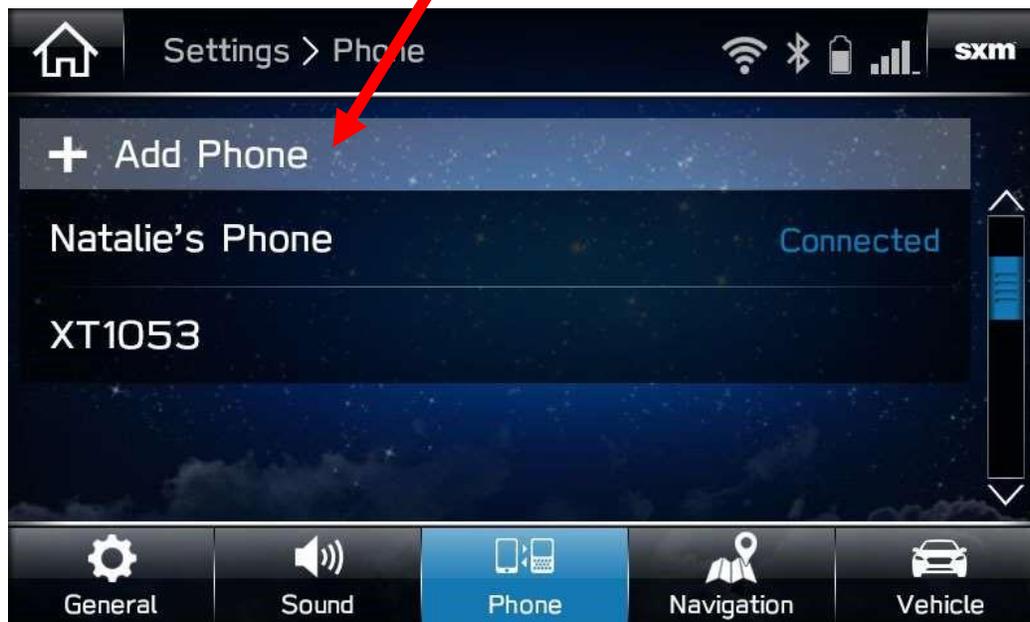


How to pair an Android device

1. Go to settings on the vehicle infotainment screen.



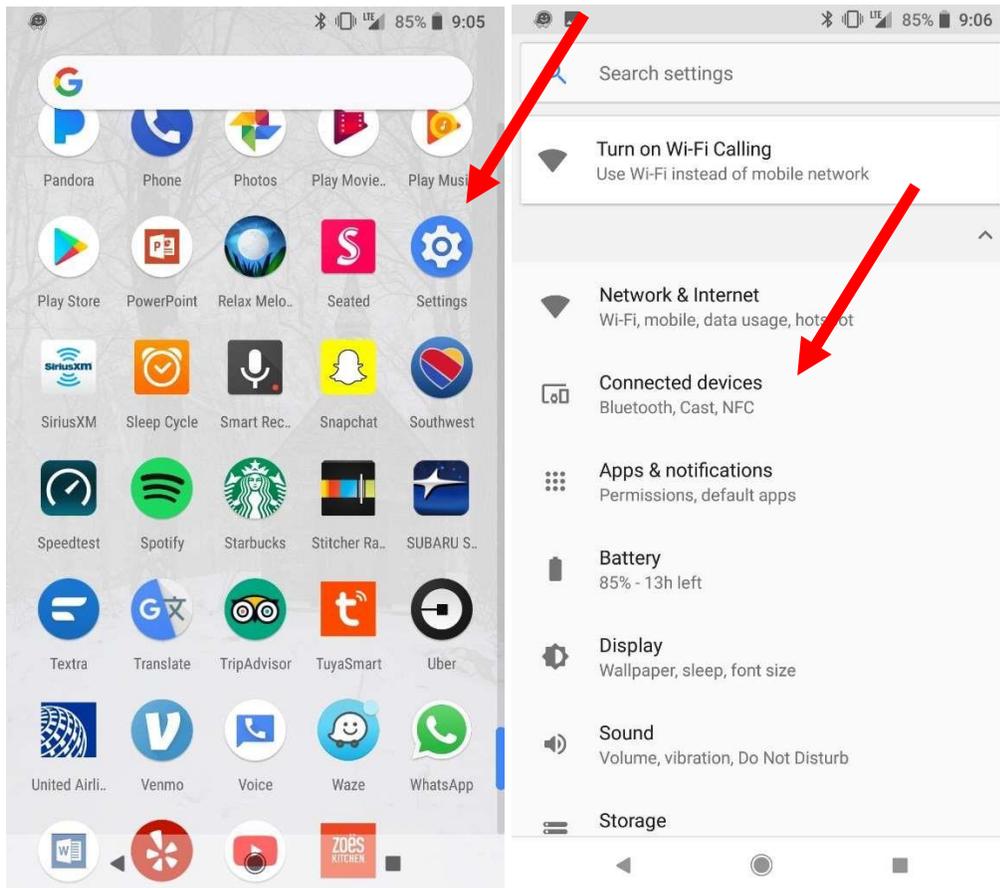
2. Go to the "Phone" page
3. Select "Add Device"/ "Add Phone"



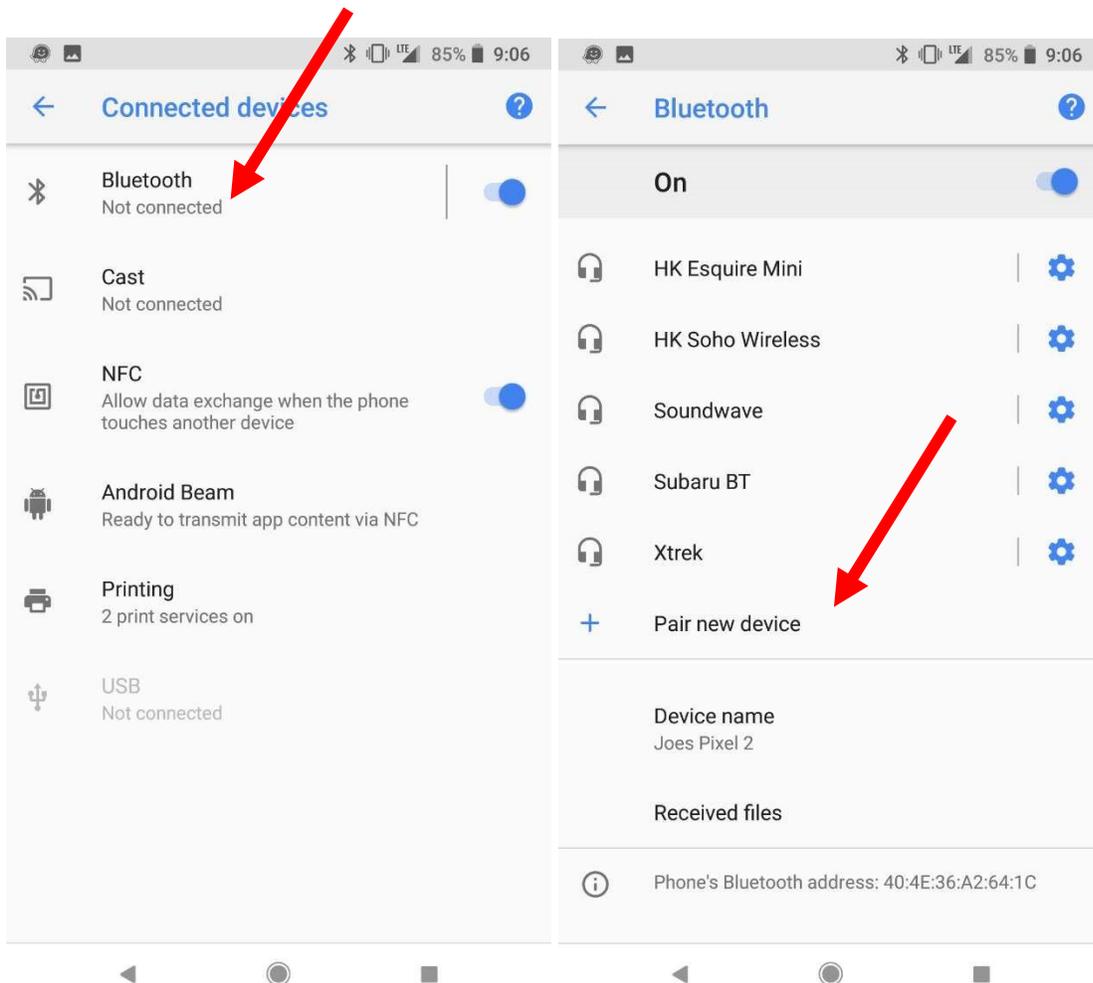
4. This screen will be displayed when pairing mode is in progress. Make note of the “device name”. Most likely it will be Subaru BT.



5. On the Android device, go to settings. This step will vary by Android device. Settings can always be found under Apps. On newer Android devices, Apps is opened by swiping UP from the bottom of the screen.
6. Select “connected devices” or “connections”.

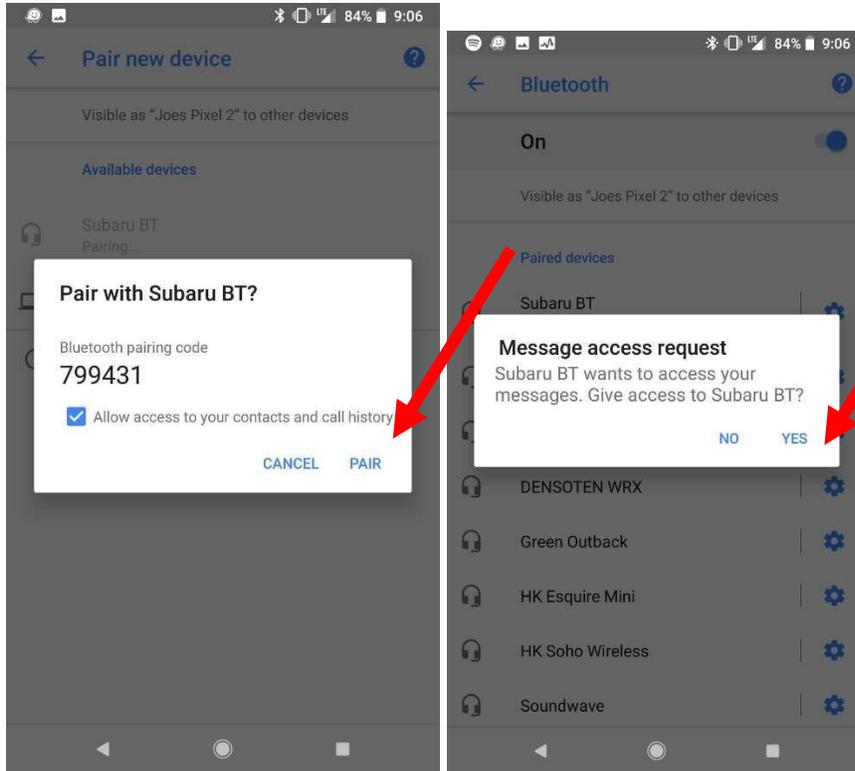


7. Select “Bluetooth”
8. At this step, either select “pair new device”, or the phone will already be showing nearby devices to add.
9. Select “Subaru BT” or whatever the device name is from step 4.

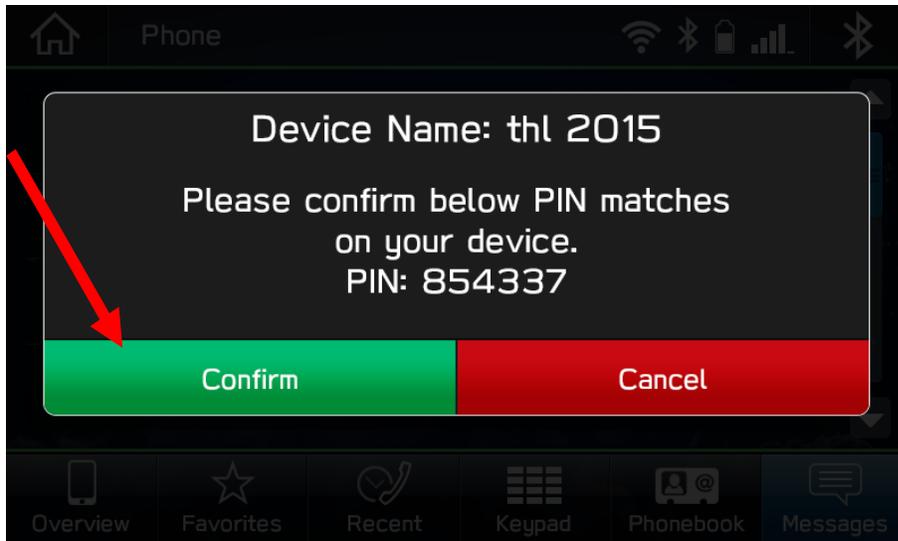
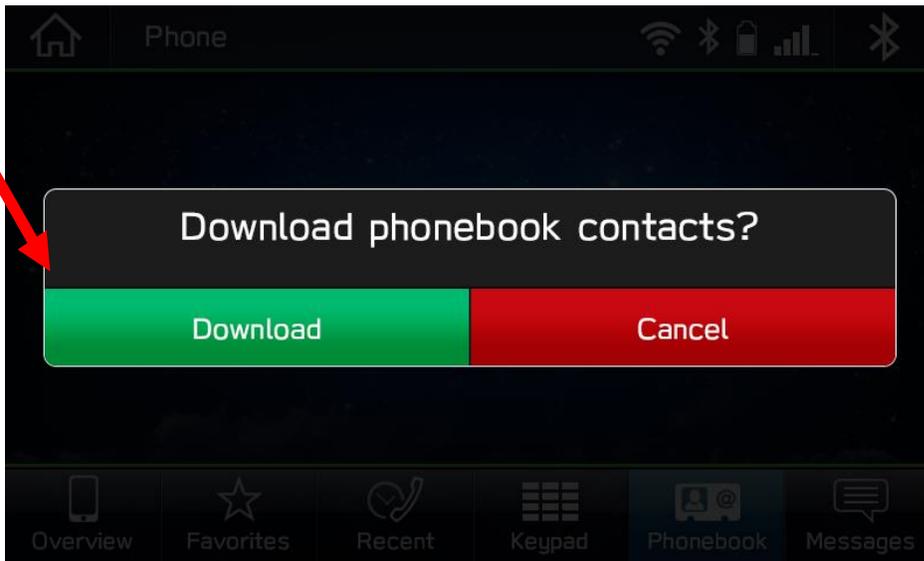


10. Select “pair” and ensure “allow access to your contacts and call history” are enabled.

11. Select “yes” to the Message Access Request” pop up.

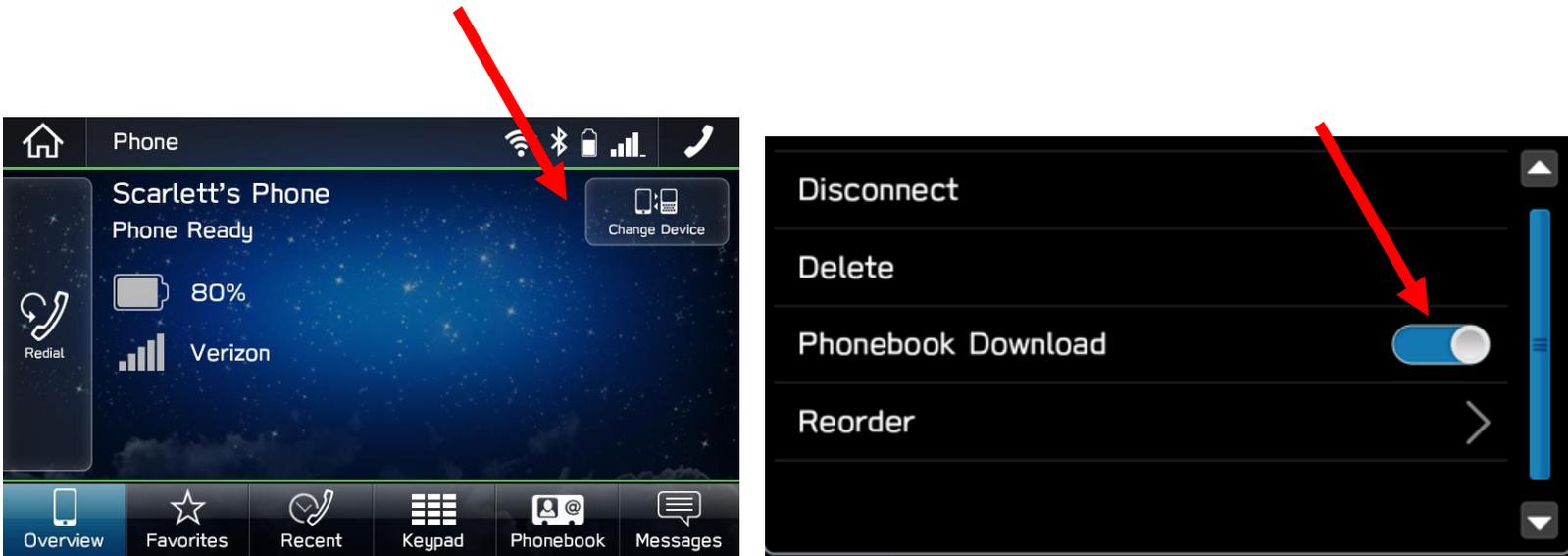


11. On the vehicle screen, download confirm the PIN and download phonebook contacts.



12. At this point, the Android phone should be paired and ready to use.

13. If your phonebook or messages are not appearing correctly, go to “Phone” on your home screen, select “change device” under “overview” and ensure “phonebook download” is enabled.



14. If you still cannot access your phonebook or messages, go back to your phones Bluetooth settings and select the gear icon next to your vehicles device name. Ensure all settings are enabled.
